

Considerations:

When planning your kitchen remodel, there are a lot of things to think about. Here we've broken down some of the most helpful considerations:

Cabinetry:

- Will your cabinets be frameless or framed?
- What door and drawer styles do you want? Will any of your doors have glass in them?
- Will your cabinets be stained or painted? What color?
- Do you want one color on the uppers and one on the bases, or all the same color?
- Do you want the interiors to match the exteriors? (Stained, painted, etc.)
- What accessories do you want inside the cabinetry? (Lazy Susan, pull-outs, drawer organizers, racks, etc.)
- What hardware do you want and where will it sit on the door/drawer?
- Will you use the same layout as your existing kitchen, or will you modify it? If you are replacing all of the cabinets, this is a great opportunity to play around with the layout of your kitchen and make it work better for you and your needs.

Countertops:

- What material do you want for your countertops? (Laminate, quartz, granite, marble, concrete, recycled glass, soapstone, solid surface, limestone, stainless steel, butcher block, etc.)
- What will the edge profile be?
- Do you want a different countertop material on the island?
- Will your backsplash match your countertop material? Or will it be tile?
- How tall will your backsplash be?

Appliances:

- Which appliances are you planning to replace or add? (Refrigerator, range, range hood, microwave, dishwasher, cooktop, wall oven, wine refrigerator, trash compactor, etc.)
- What features do you need vs. what features do you want in each appliance?
- Do you want a gas or electric range, or dual fuel? Does your home currently have natural gas or propane? If not, is either available?
- Where will each appliance be located? Does this change the work flow of the kitchen?
- What finish will your appliances have?
- Will they have Wi-Fi and "Smart Home" connectivity?

Fixtures:

- What sink installation method do you want? (Undermount, drop-in, apron-front, etc.)
- What material do you want your sink made of? (Stainless steel, porcelain, etc.)
- Will your sink be single bowl or double bowl? If it is double bowl, where do you want the split? (50/50, 60/40, 70/30, etc.)
- Do you want a garbage disposal? If so, do you want to turn it on and off with a light switch, or do you want an air switch mounted on your sink or countertop?
- What finish do you want for your faucet?
- Do you want it to have a pull down/pull out?
- Do you want it to have an on/off touch feature?
- Do you want it to have "Smart Home" connectivity?
- Do you want a pot filler over your range?

Other:

- Do you want new millwork? If so, what will it look like?
- What color do you want the kitchen walls to be?
- Will you change the existing lighting? Add a pendant light over the sink, island, or bar?
- Will you add under-cabinet task lighting?

As you can see, there is a lot to consider, and you may be feeling overwhelmed just looking at this list of questions.

But don't worry, we are here to help you.

The following pages will help you determine the style you are going for and help you make more specific decisions about fixtures, features, and finishes. We've broken each of these sections (cabinetry, countertops, appliances, etc.) down into the details (finish, installation type, additional features, etc.)

Art Deco – 20s-30s, streamlined, geometric, rounded fronts, mirrored accents, chrome, glass, sleek lines **Arts & Crafts (Craftsman)** – 1910-1925, simple form, no extraneous detail, bungalow, Frank Lloyd-Wright

Asian – Natural fiber elements, bamboo, natural colors, calm, serene, lacquered furniture, bright accessories

Bohemian – Carefree, vintage furniture, global textures, displayed collections, found objects, high & low, *laissez-faire*

Contemporary – Neutral, clean, smooth, subtle, sleek, clean, low to ground

Costal/Hamptons – Beach life, comfortable, inviting, charm, serenity, blues & whites, natural wood finishes

Cottage – Cozy & charming, fairy tale-like, quaint, treasured pieces

Country/Farmhouse – Rustic elegance, white wood & shiplap, soft florals, pops of red, handmade, wood **Eclectic** – Freedom of expression, breaking rules, mix and match, combines bits & pieces of all other styles to please

English Country – Feminine; greens, reds, pinks, & blues; fine carved wood furniture, overstuffed sofas, tufting, skirting

French – Ornate, fanciful, muted colors, repetition of a color or fabric, gold & bronze, glitz, drama **French Country** – Elegance, simplicity, effortless, old-world, rustic yet refined

Industrial – Raw, edgy, textural, grey, worn down, repurposed & recycled, mixes metals & woods, exposed brick, urban

Mediterranean – Spain, Greece, and Italy; colors from the sea; terra cotta; yellow & lavender; ornate legs; textured walls

Mid-Century Modern – 50s-60s, geometric shapes, contemporary patterns, unique, straight-forward, functionality

Minimalist – Uber modern, aesthetics of simplicity, well-edited

Modern – 30s, minimal, true use of material, absence of decoration, strong shapes, asymmetry, neutrals, polished

Moroccan – Rich history, color, & texture; gold & brass metals; warm colors; more is more

Rustic – Organic, repurposed, hand-built, used & re-used, imperfectly rough & worn

Scandinavian – Warm & cheerful, casual, light, clean, refined, natural, simplicity of life, functionality, interesting lines

Shabby Chic – Weathered, painted motifs, muted florals, white, vintage accessories, bright & airy

Spanish – Rich colors with humble natural materials, clay tile, bridge between indoor & outdoor

Traditional – Colonial era, structure, predictability, comfort, warmth, familiarity

Transitional – Bridges contemporary & traditional, cleaner lines, leather ottoman coffee tables, Crate & Barrel

Tropical – Island-life, relaxation, comfort, ease, hospitality, blues & greens & red, patterns, light & bright, seagrass

Tuscan – Old-world, rich colors & textures, elegance, drama, rustic comfortability

Western – Raw, roughhewn woods, inviting fabrics, plaid, worn leather, stone hearths & walls, natural elements
